Your information will be handled in accordance with Council's Privacy Policy and the *Information Privacy Act 2009 (Qld)* and may be released to other parties where we are required or authorised by law to do so. About Logan Plan 2025

Queensland's planning legislation (*Planning Act 2016*) sets out a framework for the creation and management of policies at state, regional and local levels to manage land use planning, assessment of proposed development and related matters. The [Logan Planning Scheme 2015](#) is the local planning instrument which governs these matters in the City of Logan. There have been multiple amendments adopted since 2015 as part of a program of continuous improvement. In 2021, Council decided to prepare a new planning scheme, Logan Plan, to ensure our 'book of rules' for growth and development aligns with updated Queensland State Government plans and
